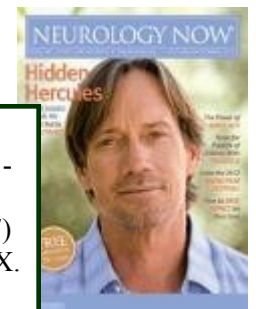

## FXAM Grant for the Xtra Xtraordinary

The Fragile X Association of Michigan will award community grants to local organizations that support our Fragile X families.

- ✘ each FXAM member family may nominate one group to receive a grant
- ✘ a group may be a nonprofit or a small not-for-profit organization
- ✘ examples of organizations you may nominate:
  - ✘ a nonprofit that runs your child's summer day camp
  - ✘ a therapeutic horseback riding program
  - ✘ a Special Olympics local organization
  - ✘ any group that enhances the life of a person with special needs
  - ✘ FXAM will not accept nominations of for-profit groups/therapists or state/national organizations
- ✘ the monetary value of the grants will be the same for all grants awarded
- ✘ the amount will be \$100 – \$250 depending on the number of nominations
  
- ✘ to nominate an organization, your family needs to do two things:
  - ✘ **send an email** to Laureen at [lmajeske1@comcast.net](mailto:lmajeske1@comcast.net) **by November 1, 2011** with:
    - ✘ the name and location of the group
    - ✘ Fed Tax ID # if the group is a tax-exempt nonprofit
    - ✘ website and/or contact info if available
    - ✘ an explanation of the group
    - ✘ how they support persons with intellectual disabilities
    - ✘ how your family is involved in the group
- AND**
  - ✘ **make a 3-5 minute informal presentation** about the nominated group at a FXAM meeting on **Nov 5, Feb 4 or Mar 3** (if you live more than one hour from Royal Oak, the way you fulfill this requirement is negotiable)

This grant program will –

- ✘ help us all learn more about organizations that support those with Fragile X
- ✘ help us support these organizations
- ✘ help organizations have more awareness of FXAM after receiving our grant!

## Development and refinement of diagnostic instruments for use with adults with ASD

Researchers at the University of Michigan and Weill Cornell Medical College are conducting a research project to adapt diagnostic observation measures to be more appropriate for use with older individuals with ASD.

### We are currently recruiting participants who:

- Are between 15 and 30 years of age
- Have limited language skills (nonverbal to phrase speech)
- Do NOT have a diagnosis of an autism spectrum disorder (participant may have other diagnoses such as Down Syndrome, Fetal Alcohol Syndrome, intellectual disability, etc.)

OR

- Are between the 15 and 30 years of age
- Are verbally fluent (complex sentences) OR have limited language skills
- Have a diagnosis of an autism spectrum disorder

All participants must also have a parent/caregiver who is able to provide information about the participant's early

development and is willing to participate. Individuals are **not** eligible for participation if they cannot complete the research measures due to sensory or motor impairment (e.g., blindness, deafness, severe cerebral palsy).

Participants and parents/caregivers will receive \$25 gift cards for participation (for a total of \$50 per family). In addition, written summaries of assessment are provided.

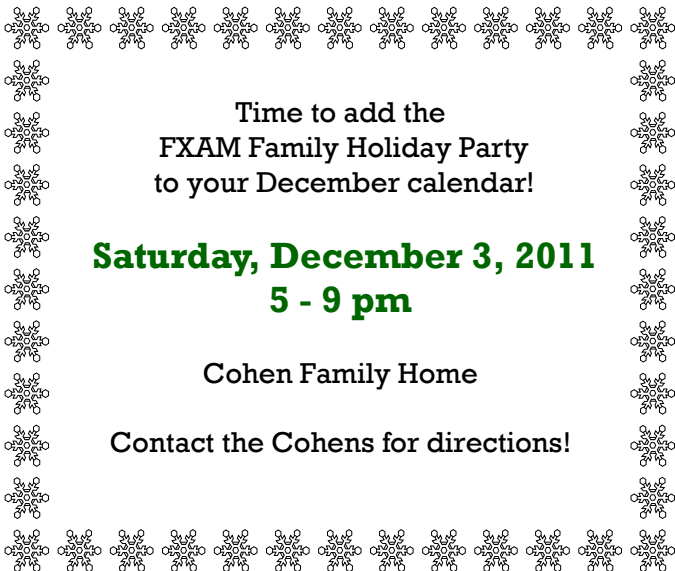
FXAM members, families and friends in support of FXAM and all of our families!

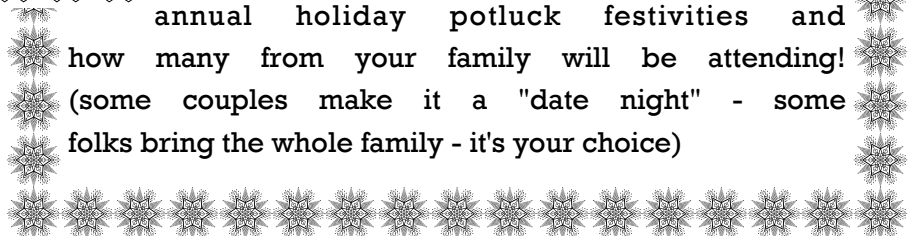
